### **EDR's VHF-UHF-SHF Juli contest**

# 1. Participants:

EDR hereby invites all licensed radio amateurs in Aaland, Denmark, Faeroe Islands, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden to the annual EDR Nordic July VHF, UHF and SHF Contest.

### 2. Date & Time:

First full weekend in July, Saturday from 1400 UTC to Sunday 1400 UTC.

#### 3. Sections:

A: Single operators B: Multi operators

C: Single/Multi 6 hours section

In each class the top 3 winners are awarded for each band.

# 4. Frequency and modes:

All VHF/UHF/SHF bands from 50 MHz and up.

All operation and modes are allowed in accordance with the IARU Region 1 bandplans.

No contacts via active repeaters or EME are allowed.

## 5. 6 Hours section:

The 6-hour time segment can be divided into maximum two periods. The time of the first QSO sets the start time of the first period. When operating in two periods, the pause between the periods must be longer than 2 hours. The first time difference of 2 hours or more between two consecutive QSOs marks the pause segment. Only the QSOs that fall into the combined 6 hour time segment will be counted for points. Participants are welcome to operate longer than 6 hours and in such case they shall send their complete log (the contest robot will automatically extract the 6 hours part from the log).

# 6. Logs:

Separate logs for each band. The log must include:

Date, time (UTC), send RS(T) and QSO number starting from 001, received RS(T) + QSO number, and locator.

Logs, must be in REGION 1 format – REG1TEST. The log must be submitted to EDR's robot at <a href="http://vushf.dk/contest">http://vushf.dk/contest</a>, not later than the second Monday following the contest weekend.

It is important that PBand and PSect in the log file matches the test you want to upload, and that time is in utc, else the system will not accept your log.

PSect must be set to one of the 3 classes, and PBand to the band.

e.g. 144 MHz single class:

PBand=144 MHz

PSect = A
